Dear Design Teacher

Attached to this letter is the Moderation Schedule. Please take note of the date on which you will be visited by the Practical Moderation Team.

For each candidate you must please have the following on display:-

**1) PAT TASK 1** (Term 1 prac), **PAT TASK 3** (Term 2 prac), **PAT TASK 5** (Term 3 prac):  
for **each** of these the following must be presented:

- an A3 tonal drawing (loose or in sourcebook)
- other design process work (in sourcebook)
- final product.

**2) The June Prac Exam**

**3) September Prac Exam**

**4) The Final Practical Exam (National)**

**4.1 Design Process Work** (in sourcebook). This could include a tonal drawing but a carefully rendered design or prototype for the final product is also acceptable.

**4.2 Final Design Product**

Each candidate's sourcebook must display:

- A completed GRADE 12 DESIGN LEARNER COVER PROGRAMME OF ASSESSMENT MARK SHEET (See ADDENDUM I) with moderated marks in green.
- the practical Brief for each Task/Prac Exam
- the rubrics which were used to mark these tasks

Also have the SBA RECORDING SHEET (ADDENDUM II) and the final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III) completed and available on the day of moderation. It will help to simplify the moderation process and moderator and final marks will be filled in on them (to be attached to the coloured computerized mark sheets).

The two coloured computerized mark sheets from the Education Department must be available with *only* the teacher's column filled in – in black. The one mark sheet requests the PAT mark out of 50 which is the exhibition mark (Task 1, 3, 5 as well as the prac exams – recalculated to 50). The November prac exam of 100 marks will be filled onto the other sheet. Your principal should already have handed in the SBA mark sheet at the district office.

Works must be exhibited in numerical order. The educator must give each candidate a number and these numbers as well as Examination numbers must be reflected on the Final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III). Each exhibition must display the candidates EXAMINATION NUMBER.

Ensure that:-

- Tasks are exhibited in the right order – Task 1, Task3 and Task 5.
- Tasks are clearly labeled Task, 1, Task 3 and Task 5.
- The Practical exams form part of this exhibition and are also clearly labeled, June, September and November.


**PLEASE TAKE NOTE:**

- All works must be displayed. Missing works cannot receive a mark.

- The September exam practical is the Design P2 September exam that has been sent out by the Department and must be done during the September Trial exam for 6 hours in a time decided between the Design teacher and the principal.
- The Design Final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III) requires of you to get an average mark for all the Practical Year work. We want to compare that mark with your End-of-Year Exhibition mark. If the Exhibition mark differs from this average, we would like you to justify why this is so. e.g. the learners might have improved a work subsequent to its original hand-in date.
- We will not remark each individual work, unless we feel that the average of the candidate is too high or too low when looking at his/her body of work.

5. Please ensure that all learners' evidence of work are in the classroom ( or district office as arranged.) There will be no leniency for learners who do not have complete portfolios present for moderation, AND NO late marking will be allowed. The form for the cover sheet has also been included.
6. Exam practical mark sheet, Addendum D: The computerised Departmental mark sheet for the final exam practical is to be filled in by the educator, in the column provided for this. The moderators will fill in the other columns. Teachers must make certain that they get this official sheet from their District Offices. The classroom back- up sheet has been attached as Addendum C. Use this also.

9. SBA = 100. This gets sent to District office before the moderators arrive.
10. EXAM = 50. This is what the moderators look at.
11. EXHIBITION MARK = 150, 75 for sourcebook, and 75 for final works. This is what the moderators look at.
12. We apologize for having to work on a Saturday and Sunday, but the length of this procedure calls for these measures. We know it is also inconvenient for some of you, who have to travel early in the mornings to get to the venue, and we salute you for doing this. We have tried to visit one or two schools previously unvisited on their own premises.
