2012 GRADE 9 FINAL EXAMINATION TIME TABLE


1. Assessment Instruction 23 of 2012, dated 12 March 2012, has reference.
2. A final timetable for the Grade 9 final examination is attached for information and further planning of teaching, learning and assessment activities. **ANNEXURE A**
3. Important information about the Grade 9 examination should be noted:
 - 3.1 The Grade 9 examination commences on Monday 12 November 2012 and concludes on Friday 23 November 2012.
 - 3.2 One session is scheduled for each day. This will commence at 9h00 and end at 11h00 daily except for Home Languages which will end at 11h30.
 - 3.3 **Principals are cautioned that altering a Provincial examination question paper is an irregularity and will result in learners having final results withheld while irregularities are investigated. This means that the entire**

question paper is to be written by all learners and the entire script is to be marked as per the marking memorandum issued by the Province. This is compulsory for all schools offering Grade 9

3.4 Marking memoranda may under no circumstances be altered if work has not been completed at the school. The learners must be awarded a zero mark for that section.

3.5 All schools are to complete all the Grade 9 Learning Outcomes in all Learning Areas offered at the school prior to the start of the examination. This is very important.

4. Principals are to ensure that this information is given to the learners and the teachers as quickly as possible.
