CERTIFICATE (NSC) NOVEMBER TIME TABLE (2015)

- 1. The Eastern Cape Department of Education received Circular E 21 of 2015 from the Department of Basic Education (DBE) on 30 July 2015.
- The Council of Education Ministers (CEM) approved the Grade 12 National Senior Certificate (NSC) November examinations (2015) Time Table which was circulated to Districts for schools in the form of Assessment Instruction 29 of 2015.
- In terms of the timetable contained in Assessment Instruction 29 both Electrical Technology and Tourism are scheduled to be written on the afternoon of Tuesday, 24 November 2015
- 4. However, after the registration data was finalized, it was discovered that some candidates have registered for Electrical Technology and Tourism. This implies clash on the Time Table.




- 5. Therefore, in order to accommodate these candidates, the following amendments have been made:
 - (a) Electrical Technology has been moved to the afternoon of Thursday, 12 November 2015, to be written together with Nautical Science and Dance Studies.
 - (b) Tourism remains where it was originally scheduled, on the afternoon of Tuesday, 24 November 2015.
- 6. All Heads of Education Institutions are requested to ensure that the contents of this memorandum, with the attached amended Time Table, is distributed to subject advisors, schools and learners who offer both Electrical Technology and Tourism.
