CERTIFICATE (NSC) NOVEMBER TIME TABLE (2015)

DATE: 28 SEPTEMBER 2015

1. The Eastern Cape Department of Education issued Assessment Instruction 29 of 2015, which deals with Time Tables for Grades 12 Trial, 11 Final and Grade 10 (Physical Sciences and Mathematics).
2. In terms of the timetables contained in Assessment Instruction 29 of 2015, Grade 11 History Paper 1 is scheduled to be written on 20 and 23 November 2015. Grade 10 Physical Sciences Paper 1 is scheduled to be written on 13 and 18 November 2015.
3. The Grade 11 Time Table has been amended as follows: History Paper 1 will be written on Friday, 20 November 2015 and History Paper 2 on Monday, 23 November 2015.
4. The amendment on Grade 10 Time Table is as follows: Physical Sciences Paper 1 will be written on Friday, 13 November 2015 and Paper 2 on Wednesday, 18 November 2015.



5. All Heads of Education Institutions are requested to ensure that the contents of this Assessment Instruction, with the attached amended Time Tables, is distributed to subject advisors, schools and learners and relevant stakeholders.
