WRITING OF THE MAY/JUNE 2020 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC)/SENIOR CERTIFICATE (SC) EXAMINATION AND TIMETABLE

- 1. The Provincial Department of Education received Circular E2 of 2020 from the Department of Basic Education regarding the 2020 May/June Examination in reference to Assessment Instruction 8 of 2020.
- 2. Please note that the 2020 May/June National Senior Certificate/Senior Certificate examination will be written from Monday, 4 May 2020 to Friday, 12 June 2020, following the same format and structure as the 2019 May/June Examination.
- 3. Find attached the timetable (ANNEXURE A) for the 2020 May/June Examinations.
- 4. The May/June 2020 examination can be written by both the National Senior Certificate (NSC) candidates and Senior Certificate (SC) candidates.
- 5. The May/June 2020 examination is an examination that is identical to the November 2019 NSC examination and all subjects offered in the November 2019 examination will be offered in the May/June 2020 Examination. However, subjects marked with an asterisk can only be written by SC candidates.



- 6. The following NSC candidates can register to write the May/June 2020 examination:
 - (a) Candidates who wrote the November NSC examination that do not meet the requirements of the NSC but wish to improve their performance either in terms of the subject, or the type of pass obtained, may register to write the 2020 May/June examination.
 - (b) If a candidate was indisposed due to ill-health or if there was a death in the immediate family or if for other special reasons a candidate was unable to write one or more question papers in the 2019 November examination, he or she may register for the 2020 May/June examination.
 - (c) Progressed learners who opted for the multiple examinations opportunity (MEO) dispensation and wrote only a limited number of subjects in the November 2019 NSC examination, need to complete the outstanding subjects in the May/June 2020 examination.
 - (d) NSC candidates wishing to write the May/June examination must have completed their School Based Assessment (SBA), Practical Assessment Tasks (PATs) and Language Oral marks in a previous NSC examination; and
 - (e) Candidates may not register for a subject with a practical component, or for Languages, unless they have previously registered for such a subject, and have a mark for the PAT component in that subject or in the case of Languages, have an oral mark.
- 7. Senior Certificate (SC) candidates can register to write the May/June 2020 examination and the criteria is as follows:
 - (a) Adult candidates who are 21 years and older who have:
 - (i) a GETC: or
 - (ii) a Grade 9 school report, stating that they have passed Grade 9; or
 - (iii) a recognised equivalent qualification obtained at NQF Level 1.
 - (b) Adult candidates with an incomplete Senior Certificate qualification written prior to 2015, who are 21 years and older on the first day of the month in which 2020 May/June examination is conducted; and
 - (c) Out-of-school youth, 18–21 years who could not complete their FET school education and who can no longer be accommodated in the school system due to the special circumstances as verified by the Head of Department, provided further that they satisfy the requirements stipulated in (7)(a).



- 8. It needs to be noted that in terms of the Regulations pertaining to the Conduct, Administration and Management of the National Senior Certificate Examination, the validity period attached to the SBA has been scrapped with effect from 2019. This implies that the SBA, PAT or Oral Marks completed by a candidate for the National Senior Certificate, is valid for as long as it takes the candidate to satisfy the requirements of the NSC or improve his results.
- 9. In terms of paragraph (7), no candidate should be expected to migrate from the National Senior Certificate (NSC) to the Senior Certificate (SC), as was the case in previous years, due to the expiry of the validity period of the SBA. NSC candidates that are 21 years and older must register as part-time candidates for the 2020 May/June examination.
