**GRADE 12 JUNE COMMON EXAMINATIONS:
ANALYSIS OF LEARNER PERFORMANCE**


1. In improving provincial assessment standards to ensure quality and efficiency in academic achievement of Grade 12 learners, June Common Examinations have been set and moderated by seasoned setting panels.
2. The writing of these standardized assessments commenced on 30 May and will be completed on 21 June 2022.
3. In order to accurately interpret the performance of Grade 12 learners, the Province will analyse the performance levels received by learners so as to use the data to draw valid inferences about the learner performance for focused interventions by relevant officials and stakeholders.
4. Learner performance data collection tool is herein attached to this Assessment Instruction to all Principals and relevant stakeholders, however, if there is a school that
