2022 GRADE 11 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE NOVEMBER COMMON EXAMINATION DRAFT TIMETABLE

- 1. This Assessment Instruction serves to inform all schools offering Grade 11 that there will be a provincially set common final examinations for high enrolment subjects in 2022.
- 2. The draft timetable for the Grade 11 November Examination is attached as **ANNEXURE A.**

- 3. The question papers have been set in line with the Annual Teaching Plans (ATPs) and the 2022 examination guidelines.
- 4. It was the norm in the past that provincial examinations were set to ensure that common standards were set and to ensure that examinations and assessment in conducted in a fair and equitable manner. These examinations also served as an important diagnostic exercise and enabled the development and implementation of timeous intervention strategies.





- 5. The disruptive influence of the Covid-19 pandemic and its impact on the learning environment necessitated that different assessment strategies had to be employed. In order to ensure that a return to a more balanced approach to assessment utilised and in line with some of the reasons mentioned it was decided to have a common Grade 11 examination in 2022.
- 6. However, with due recognition of the impact of the pandemic on the learning environment it was decided to phase in the common examination. Therefore, for the final examination a limited number of provincial examination question papers will be provided in 2022.
- 7. Schools are reminded to set their own question papers for the subjects which do not appear on this timetable and find a suitable slot within the existing timetable. Question papers set at school level, must be moderated by HODs.
- 8. The papers that will be provided have undergone rigorous and stringent moderation and other quality assurance processes to ensure that they comply with all applicable regulations.
