ADMINISTRATION OF GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE (GEC) PILOT TESTS

- 1. The curriculum tests are an important part of the 360° assessment model as they cover the CAPS content required for Term 3 and 4.
- 2. Department of Basic Education is piloting the GEC in selected schools across the 9 provinces from 17 November to 24 November 2022. The list of selected schools for the pilot project is attached as Annexure A.
- 3. Following are the Five subjects identified for the pilot projects in 2022. They are
 - 3.1. English/Afrikaans First Additional Language
 - 3.2. Home Language
 - 3.3. Mathematics
 - 3.4. EMS
 - 3.5. Natural Sciences

5. Districts and schools are requested to adhere to the start and end time as stipulated on the timetable.

6. Marking of GEC Tests

- 6.1. Marking guideline discussion will be done before the marking of learners' scripts.
- 6.2. Standardised marking guidelines will be sent to schools after the subject has been written.

7. Moderation of learners' scripts

- 7.1. Moderation of standardised Curriculum Tests should happen in line with already existing internal school moderation processes.
- 7.2. A sample should be drawn and moderated by the Head of Department/Senior teacher/subject head.
- 7.3. Anomalies should be handled in terms of the school's internal processes.

8. Remarking

- 8.1. Department of Basic Education (DBE) will sample scripts of the learners in one class and will be forwarded to DBE for remarking during December 2022.
- 8.2. Schools are therefore requested to keep all the learners' script in a safe place after the moderation process.
