### 2010 GRADE 12 TRIAL EXAMINATION

- 1. Assessment Instruction 20 of 2010, dated 05 March 2010, has reference.
- An amended time table for the Grade12 Trial examination is attached for information and further planning of teaching, learning and assessment activities.

## 3. 2010 GRADE 12 TRIAL TIME TABLE AMENDMENTS

- The examination commences on Tuesday 24 August 2010 and concludes on Wednesday 22 September 2010.
- Two sessions are scheduled for each day. The morning session will commence at 09h00 and the afternoon session will commence at 14h00. Schools with Muslim learners have indicated a challenge starting the second session at 14h00 on Fridays. These schools may commence these papers at 15h00 if necessary.
- Comments, recommendations and concerns received about the Trials time table have been considered when drawing up the final timetable.
- Kindly note that many candidates are required to write two subjects a
  day. That is the reason for having a morning session that allows a
  minimum of 2 hours rest before the commencement of the afternoon
  session. The academic disadvantage experienced by candidates,
  mentioned in some of the concerns received from schools, is noted,
  however time constraints do not allow for extension of the duration of
  the examination.

- Subjects indicated in grey scale are amendments that have been made to the time table. As previously indicated this Trial examination is a collaboration between Provinces and a common time table was issued. However due to the Jewish/Muslim holidays, Afrikaans 1<sup>st</sup> Additional cannot be written in the Eastern Cape as previously time tabled. Kindly note the changes that have been effected. This has meant moving Agricultural Science paper 1 and 2. The inconvenience is regretted.
- A number of question papers will not be supplied by the Province and must be set at school. These subjects were indicated in Assessment Instruction 20 of 2010. Kindly note however, that due to circumstances beyond the control of the Province, Information Technology P1 and P2 and Music P1 and P2 have been added to this list and schools offering these subjects are required to set question papers.
- Principals are cautioned that altering a Provincial examination question paper is an irregularity and will result in candidates having final results withheld while SBA irregularities are investigated. This means that the entire Trial question paper is to be written by all candidates and the entire script is to be marked as per the marking memorandum issued by the Province.
- Marking memoranda may under no circumstances be altered if work has not been completed at the school. The candidates must receive zero marks for that section.
- All schools are to complete all the Grade 12 outcomes in all subjects
  offered at the school prior to the start of the Trial examination. This is
  very important.
- 4. Principals are to ensure that this information is given to the learners and the teachers as quickly as possible. The co-operation of all stakeholders in the process is appreciated.
