**EXAMINATION GUIDELINES FOR OFFICIAL LANGUAGES FOR GRADE 12
NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS (NSC) 2011**

- 1 The contents of this Assessment Instruction are as per National Department of Basic Education's Circular E7 of 2011 dated 21 June 2011.
- 2 The Examination Guidelines for ALL languages were issued in 2009. Since then, there has been no revision or amendments to the languages Examination Guidelines.
- 3 Teachers and subject advisors are advised to use the 2009 Examination Guidelines for ALL languages to prepare Grade 12 learners for the 2011 National Senior Certificate examinations for languages.



- 4 Examination guidelines for ALL languages were sent to all schools as an annexure of Assessment Instruction 14 of 2009, dated 23 February 2009.
- 5 Principals are to ensure that this information is provided to all teachers and learners as urgently as possible.
- 6 The co-operation of all education stakeholders in the process is both anticipated and appreciated.
