GRADE 12 TRIAL EXAMINATION: FINAL TIME TABLE

The 2008 Grade 12 Trial Examination final time table is attached.

School Principals are kindly requested to note the following:

1. Question papers will be supplied by the Province. The large subjects are being written nationally and these papers have been set by National examiners and moderators. The question papers have been externally moderated by UMALUSI.
2. The Trial examination is compulsory for all schools that have registered NSC candidates. This is a national time table hence scheduled dates and times cannot be compromised. The examination commences on Tuesday 26 August 2008 and ends on Thursday 25 September 2008.
3. Question papers for the subjects indicated below will not be supplied by the Province and schools are to set those subjects internally. A copy of the question papers and memo are to be forwarded to the District office for submission to the Assessment and Examinations Directorate. These subjects are:
 - Agricultural Management
 - Agricultural Technology
 - Dramatic Arts
 - Information Technology
 - Visual Arts
 - SeSotho 1st and 2nd Additional Language P 1/2/3

4. This examination must be written in accordance with the rules and regulations governing public examinations. Chief Invigilators are reminded that all Irregularities will be investigated
5. Should there be a clash of subjects, the isolation rule is to be applied. Care has been taken to separate the subjects that were reported as clashes on the final NSC time table.
6. Marking memoranda will be supplied by the Province. All schools are expected to mark the question papers using the marking memo supplied. Schools may report challenges and variances to the Provincial office through the District Office for consideration.
7. A copy of the time table should be distributed immediately to all teachers, learners and parents to enable preparation for the Trial examination.
