<p>GRADE 9 COMMON TASKS FOR ASSESSMENT (CTA): INFORMATION AND MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS</p>
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1. COLLECTION DATE

Schools with Grade 9 learners will administer the CTA A Section in the 4th term. The CTA Section A will be available for schools to collect from District Offices on Monday 15 September 2008.

CTA 2008 – MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS

No.	Learning Area	Material Requirements
1	ALL Home Languages	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Pen and pencil.
2	ALL 1 st Additional Languages	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Pen and pencil
3	ALL 2nd Additional Languages	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Pen and pencil
4	Arts and Culture Kuns en Kultuur	Sections A and B – Pre-printed Answer Books provided. Section A – Costume for performance; Stage props; Feet rattles; Drums; Vuvuzela; Sports clothing; Whistle/flute; Paints; Soccer fan props; Rostra for elevation to create levels like grandstands. Section B – Pen, pencil, coloured pencils (especially green, gold, yellow and other colours).
5	EMS EBW	Sections A and B – Pre-printed Answer Books provided. Section A – create an advertisement – coloured pencils.
6	Life Orientation Lewensorientering	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Section A and B – Highlighters or coloured pencils. Section A only – scrap pictures for collage. MOVEMENT ACTIVITIES Depending on which game the learners will choose – refer to page 19 of Learners’ Book. Section A Flags; Basketball; Soccer ball; Skittle or markers (could also improvise and use plastic bottles filled with sand) to mark off field; Hoops; Netball; Cricket ball / bat; Baseball / bat; Batons; Volley ball; Music / CD player. Indigenous game rule book; obtainable from the Sport and Recreation offices (Resource may be added into the web page). Apparatus needed if indigenous games are chosen: Balls, skipping ropes, pen, jukskei, markers.
7	Mathematics Wiskunde	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, approved calculator. (Programmable calculators are not allowed).
8	Natural Sciences Natuurwetenskappe	Sections A and B – Pre-printed Answer Books provided. Section A – Two cells (torch batteries); two connecting wires with very low resistance; 1 conductor; Support stand (for Conductor).
9	Social Sciences Sosialewetenskappe	Sections A and B -Provide Answer Books Section B – Topographical map provided with Section A; Coloured pencils, protractor (paper sample has been provided in the resource pack); Calculator (for measurement); Chart (for designing posters).
10	Technology Tegnologie	Sections A and B – Pre-printed Answer Books provided. Section A – Wood, rope, knives, string, glue, dowel sticks, pliers, hacksaw, Perspex, masonite, 3 ply, hardboard, wire snips craft, library, internet access, cello tape, rubber belt, nails, cut-board, wires, pen, pencil, eraser, ruler.
