MANAGEMENT OF THE MAY/JUNE 2014 SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Circular E17 of 2013 has been received from the Department of Basic Education with reference to the management of the 2014 Senior Certificate Examination. (See attached Circular E17 as ANNEXURE A)
- 1.2 The number of technical errors and serious acts of misconduct in the Senior Certificate examination must be reduced and any other additional measures that will improve the conduct and administration of the 2014 Senior Certificate examination will be implemented.
- 1.3 All District offices, schools and service providers to Senior Certificate candidates are requested to ensure that the following critical decisions are implemented with regard to the 2014 Senior Certificate examination.

2. REGISTRATION OF CANDIDATES

- 2.1 The Senior Certificate examinations for May/June 2014 will be based on the reduced number of examination question papers as set out in Government Notice No 539 in Government Gazette No. 34401 of 28 June 2011.
- 2.2 The following persons can be allowed to register for the 2014 Senior Certificate examination:
 - 2.2.1 Adults who are 21 years and older, who have a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC) for Adult Basic Education and Training (ABET) or an equivalent qualification.
 - 2.2.2 Adult learners who are 21 years and older with an incomplete Senior Certificate qualification.
- 2.3 For the May/June 2014 Senior Certificate examination the closing date for registration is 30 November 2013.
- 2.4 Preliminary registration schedules will be available for inspection by candidates in March 2014 at District Offices. This process is an important activity which aims to give all candidates an opportunity to verify their registration so that there will be no changes to the registration post this process.
- 2.5 Non-registered candidates will not be allowed to write the May/June 2014 Senior Certificate examination.

3. REGISTRATION FORM (ANNEXURE B)

- 3.1 Candidates are to complete the attached registration form.
- 3.2 District Offices are to ensure that these candidates qualify to register in terms of 2.2 above.
- 3.3 A certified copy of a statement of results is required as proof of previous attempts at acquiring a Senior Certificate. The examination number is a mandatory field on the registration form. (2.2.1/2.2.2)
- 3.4 The provision of a cell phone number is mandatory. It is envisaged that the Department of Basic Education will communicate with candidates by SMS from time to time.

4. Support to Candidates

- 4.1.1 The Department of Basic Education (DBE) together with Higher Education will explore different strategies to provide a co-ordinated approach to support the 2014 cohort of adult learners. Districts, however, are encouraged to continue supporting the 2014 Senior Certificate cohort which could either be in the form of tuition/lessons or learning support material.



CIRCULAR E17 OF 2013

MANAGEMENT OF THE MAY/JUNE 2014 SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION

1. Registration of candidates

- a) The Minister of Basic Education, in terms of Sections 3(4)(1) and 7 of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No.27 of 1996), granted approval for the extension of the Senior Certificate examination until May/June 2014. However, in view of the fact that the National Senior Certificate for Adults (NASCA), will not be ready for full implementation in 2015, the Minister of Basic Education and the Minister of Higher Education and Training has subsequently approved the offering of the Senior Certificate, post 2014, in a modified format, until the NASCA is implemented.
- b) The Senior Certificate examinations for May/June 2014 will be based on the reduced number of examination question papers, as set out in *Government Notice No.539, Government Gazette No 34401 of 26 June 2011*.
- c) The following persons can be allowed to register for the 2014 Senior Certificate examination:
 - i. Adults who are 21 years and older who have a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC) for Adult Basic Education and Training (ABET) or an equivalent qualification.
 - ii. Adult learners who are 21 years and older with an incomplete Senior Certificate qualification
- d) The closing date for final registration to write the May/June 2014 Senior Certificate examination is 30 September 2013.
- e) The capture of the 2013 candidate registration must be completed by 31 January 2014.


- f) Preliminary registration schedules must be available for inspection by candidates by March 2014. The exact date will be agreed upon at the next NEAC meeting.
- g) It is expected of PEDs to strongly advocate that non registered candidates will not be allowed to write the May/June 2014 Senior Certificate examination.

2. Support to Candidates

- a) The Department of Basic Education (DBE) together with Higher Education will explore different strategies to provide a co-ordinated approach to support the 2014 cohort of adult learners. PEDs however, are encouraged to continue supporting the 2014 SC cohort which could either be in the form of tuition/lessons or learning support material.

3. You are kindly requested to bring this to the attention of all schools and teachers involved.

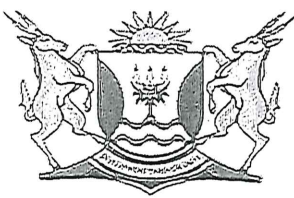
