THE 2014 ANNUAL NATIONAL ASSESSMENT GUIDELINES

- 1. The Department of Basic Education (DBE) has developed assessment guidelines for each grade and subject (Languages and Mathematics), which outline the scope of the curriculum that needs to be covered by schools prior to the writing of the ANA tests in 2014.
- 2. This will ensure that there is clarity amongst all teachers and learners in terms of the content coverage relating to the ANA tests, given that the tests will be written in the 3rd quarter of 2014.
- 3. The guidelines have been made available for provincial and district distribution. They will also be posted on the DBE's website.
- 4. Provincial Examination Sections and official responsible for coordination ANA processes must ensure that all district curriculum support staff and principals of schools receive the assessment guidelines.
