GRADE 12 SENIOR CERTIFICATE (SC) EXAMINATION TIMETABLE (2015) AND NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATION TIME TABLE (2015)

- 1. The Provincial Department of Education received Circular E5 OF 2015 on 17 February 2015 from the Department of Basic Education (DBE).
- The Council of Education Ministers (CEM) has approved the Grade 12 Senior Certificate (SC) examination (2015) timetable (Annexure A) and the National Senior Certificate (NSC) October/November examination (2015) timetable (Annexure B).
- 3. Subjects for the 2015 Senior Certificate examination are scheduled to be written from Monday, 1 June to Friday, 3 July 2015.
- 4. The Districts must note that Senior Certificate examinations will also be written on Saturdays and during school holidays and Districts must ensure that arrangements are made to accommodate the writing of examinations on Saturdays and during school holidays.




- 5. For the Senior Certificate examination, all subjects written during the first four weeks, except for the Saturday sessions, are scheduled for the afternoon session commencing at 14:00.
- 6. The National Senior Certificate examination is scheduled to be written from Monday, 26 October to Friday, 27 November 2015, comprising of a morning session commencing at 9:00 and an afternoon session commencing at 14:00.
- 7. The Heads of all Education Institutions should ensure that these time tables are distributed to all Grade 12 teachers, learners and relevant stakeholders.
