ERRATA

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. QUESTIONS 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4 must not be marked.
- 2. The paper is to be marked out of 86.
- 3. Final mark to be converted to 100.

We request that this must be brought to the attention of all educators marking these papers and sincerely apologise for the inconvenience.
