#### NOVEMBER/DECEMBER 2021 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS TIMETABLE

- At the Council of Education Ministers (CEM) meeting held on Wednesday, 19 May 2021, the 2021 November/December NSC Examination Timetable was discussed and approved (ANNEXURE A).
- 2. The 2021 November/December NSC examinations are scheduled to be written from **Monday, 1 November 2021** to **Tuesday, 7 December 2021.**

- 3. The schools will close for learners on **Friday**, **10 December 2021** and for teachers on **Wednesday**, **15 December 2021**.
- 4. Examinations will start later than usual to allow for maximum teaching and learning time and the timetable will follow the timetable format of previous years, thus the examinations will extend over a period of 6 weeks.
- 5. The Life Orientation (LO) Common Assessment Task will be written on **Monday**, **6 September 2021**, with its re-write (i.e. LO Common Assessment Task) scheduled for **Wednesday**, **13 October 2021**.



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- Computer Applications Technology (CAT) and Information Technology (IT) Paper 1, practical, will be written on Tuesday, 19 October 2021 and Wednesday, 20 October 2021 respectively.
- 7. Candidates and teachers to also take note of the following important changes:
  - (a) Geography Paper 1 and Paper 2 are now both 3 hours and will be written on separate days:
    - (i) Geography P1: (Climate and Weather, Geomorphology and Mapwork).
    - (ii) Geography P2: (Rural and Urban Settlement, Economic Geography of SA and Mapwork).
  - (b) All Home Languages Paper 3 are now 3-hour papers compared to 2½ hrs previously.
  - (c) A third paper has been added to all Second Additional Languages. The duration of these SAL papers (P3) are 2½ hrs duration.
  - (d) Marine Sciences (Paper 1 and Paper 2) is offered for the first time at Grade 12 level.
