CORRECTION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED ASSESSMENT (SBA) MARKS CAPTURED FOR CIVIL TECHNOLOGY ON THE SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SASAMS)

- 1. This assessment Instruction serves to correct the incorrect SA-SAMS School-Based Assessment (SBA) weightings for Civil Technology (all three specializations).
- 2. Circular S8 of 2023 provided the correct weightings for Civil Technology as per the table below:

- 3. In order to correct this error, the following procedure will be followed by schools and district offices:
 - (a) An amendment to SA-SAMS issued to the PED with the corrections to Civil Technology.

- (b) The amendment to SA-SAMS must be distributed to all schools and districts must ensure that every school receives the updated EMQ file.
- (c) All schools must apply the updated EMQ file that will re-calculate the Civil Technology marks.
- (d) New NSC mark must be supplied to schools for Civil Technology in a (blue) colour by districts. The District Subject Advisors and District Heads of Exams must ensure that the OLD mark sheets are collected from schools, before the NEW mark sheets are issued to avoid confusing the old mark sheets with the new mark sheets. Both marks sheet must be submitted by Monday, the 06 November 2023.
- (e) Schools must then print the corrected SA-SAMS mark sheet and transfer the marks to the NEW NSC mark sheet.
- (f) Principals and Departmental Heads (HODs) must sign off both the SA-SAMS and NEW NSC mark sheets.
- (g) The District Subject Advisor (DSA) must quality assure both the SA-SAMS and the NEW NSC mark sheets in terms of:
 - Marks are correctly transferred to the NEW NSC mark sheets.
 - The District subject advisors must sign off both the SA-SAMS and the NEW NSC mark sheets.
- (h) Both the SA-SAMS and the NEW NSC mark sheets must be submitted to the Exams PED for capture of the marks onto the Integrated Examination Computer System (IECS).
- 4. The following table provides the key dates in terms of the management of these changes to the Civil Technology SBA marks:

The PED to collect the OLD NSC mark sheets and distribute the NEW NSC marks to schools (Civil Technology)	30 October 2023
Schools print the corrected SA-SAMS mark sheet and transfer the marks to the NEW NSC mark sheet.	30 October 2023
Principal and Departmental Head at the school signs off.	30 October 2023
Submission to the District Office	6 November 2023
