ADMINISTRATION OF GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE 2023

- 1. The overall goal of the General Education Certificate (GEC) is to recognize the holistic skill-set for learners over the schooling in GET.
- The Department of Basic Education is piloting the GEC in selected schools across the 9 Provinces from 15 November to 21 November 2023. The list of selected schools for the pilot project are attached as Annexure A
- 3. To ensure quality teaching and learning, DBE has introduced a pilot study for GEC for a period of three (3) years.
- 4. GEC is an assessment that forms part of the National Assessment framework (NAF) to assist learners in establishing pathways after10 years of schooling i.e., Occupational stream, Vocational stream, and the Academic stream.
- 5. Following are the five subjects for the pilot project in 2023:
 - 5.1. Home languages
 - 5.2. Mathematics(P1): Numbers, operations and Relationships and Patterns, Functions and Algebra
 - 5.3. EMS(P2): the Economy and Entrepreneurship
 - 5.4. Natural Sciences

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5.5. First Additional Language

6. Please Note:

- Test papers for GEC subjects above will be collected on the day of the examination above from the district's examinations and Assessment office by School Principals.
- Schools need to set the papers for MATHS P2: Geometry, Measurement and data handling and EMS P1: Financial literacy and the four other remaining subjects.
- 7. Exemplars will be provided by DBE on the first week of term 4 for these subjects.

9. Marking of GEC test

- 8.1 Marking guideline discussion will be done before the marking of learners scripts.
- 8.2 Standardized marking guidelines will be sent to the schools after the subject has been written.

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10. Moderation of Scripts

- 10.1 Moderation of standardized Curriculum Tests should happen in line with existing internal school moderation processes.
- 10.2 A sample should be drawn and moderated by the Head of Department/Senior teacher/subject head.
- 10.3 Anomalies should be handled in terms of the schools' internal processes.

11. Remarking

- 11.1 Department of Basic Education (DBE) will sample scripts of the learners in one class and will be forwarded to DBE for remarking during December 2023.
- 11.2 Schools are therefore requested to keep all the learner's scripts in a safe place after the moderation process.
- 12. The cooperation of all education stakeholders in this important process is both anticipated and appreciated.
