GRADE 12 2025 OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATION TIMETABLE AND RELEASE OF RESULTS OF THE 2025 OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATION

- At the Council of Education ministers (CEM) meeting held on Tuesday
 8 April 2025, the 2025 October/November, National Senior Certificate examination timetable and the date for the release of results was approved.
- 2. Annexure A is attached as the 2025 October/November Grade 12 timetable.
- 3. The 2025 October/November, National Senior Certificate examination will officially commence on Tuesday,21st October 2025 with the writing of Computer Application Technology Paper 1 (Practical's) and conclude on Thursday 27th November 2025, with the rewrite of Computer Applications Technology, Paper 1 (Practical's) and Information Technology, Paper 1 (Practical's)

- 4. It needs to be noted that in Week 1, English, Paper 3 and Afrikaans, Paper 3 will be written on Thursday,23rd October 2025 and Friday,24th October 2025 respectively. The Paper 3 for the African Languages, namely, isiZulu, isiXhosa, isiNdebele, Sesotho, Setswana, Sepedi,siSwati, Tshivenda and Xitsonga will be written in Week 2 on Monday, 27th October 2025 and Tuesday, 28th October 2025. Paper 3 in all the Languages comprises, Creative writing. Candidates must be reminded that Paper 3 will be written, before Paper 1 and Paper 3.
- The life Orientation (LO) Common Assessment Task will be written on Monday 1st September 2025, with the rewrite (i.e. LO Common Assessment Task) scheduled for Tuesday 14th October 2025.
- 6. The Minister will announce the 2025 October/November examination results on **Monday** ,12 **January 2026** and the Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) will release the results to candidates on, **Tuesday**, 13 **January 2026**.
- 7. District heads of examinations are requested to bring the contents of this Assessment Instruction to the attention of all schools and other relevant stakeholders.
