### 2010 COMMON TESTS FOR GRADES 3, 6 AND 9: MARKING, MODERATION, RECORDING AND REPORTING GUIDELINES

### A BACKGROUND

- 1. The provincial tests for Grades 3, 6 and 9 flow from the mandate of the Office of the Presidency and are linked to the Annual National Assessments (ANA) conducted by the National Department of Basic Education.
- The Assessment Instructions issued in 2010 and relating to Common Tests should be operationalised in keeping with the National directives outlined in number 1 above:
  - Assessment Instruction 12 of 2010 dated 23 February 2010
  - Assessment Instruction 27 of 2010 dated 26 April 2010
  - Assessment Instruction 30 of 2010 dated 19 May 2010.
- **3.** This Assessment Instruction is intended to provide direction and clarity with regard to the marking, moderation, recording and reporting aspects of the Common Tests.

## B. MARKING

- **1.** Marking shall be done by the teachers and internal school moderation procedures shall apply.
- 2. The provincial marking memorandum, which shall be released to schools by District Offices immediately after the paper has been written, must be used in awarding marks to learners,
- 3. The question paper and marking memorandum is intended to standardise teaching, learning and assessment across the province.
- 4. Despite the diversity in teaching approaches, styles and methodology, it is anticipated that classroom activities would have been aligned to the pacesetters provided.
- In the process of marking and moderation, it must be ensured that no learners are prejudiced. All enquires in this regard should be directed to the CES: Curriculum in District Offices who have been briefed on how to respond to such queries.

# C. MANAGEMENT PLAN: MARKING, MODERATION, RECORDING AND REPORTING OF JUNE COMMON TESTS.

1. The Management Plan to be followed for marking, moderation, recording and reporting on the common tests are outlined below:

# D. COMPLETION OF ANALYSIS RESULT FORMS BY SCHOOLS

- 1. The analysis forms provided must be submitted to the District Office no later than Monday 7 June 2010.
- 2. The school principal must complete the attached **Analysis Sheet** for:
  - Grade 3 Learners (Annexure 1).
  - Grade 6 Learners (Annexure 2).
  - Grade 9 Learners (Annexure 3).
- 3. Only the results of the common tests are to appear on the Analysis Sheet.
- A conversion table has been supplied on the back of Annexure 1 for Grade 3 to convert marks to the Level Descriptors for analysis purposes.
  Grade 6 marks are out of 50 and will be doubled to 100 for the purpose of analysis.
  Grade 9 marks are out of 100 and no conversion is necessary for the purpose of analysis.

## E. COMPLETION OF ANALYSIS RESULT FORMS BY DISTRICTS

- 1. District Directors are to ensure that all marks for the common tests are received from schools. District officials are required to follow-up and ensure full compliance by all schools by 09 June 2010.
- 2. No school is permitted to close for the 2<sup>nd</sup> term unless Common Test marks have been submitted to the District Office.
- 3. The Districts are to analyse the results of all the schools in the District. This shall be done on the forms provided as Annexures 4, 5 and 6 with this Assessment Instruction.
- 4. This District analysis is to be submitted to the office of the Cluster Chief Director no later than <u>14 June 2010.</u>

### F. CONCLUSION

It is envisaged that this Assessment Instruction will assist teachers, Heads of Departments (HOD), School Management Teams (SMT), Principals and District Officials in managing the Common Tests in Grades 3, 6 & 9 in a uniform manner.

The co-operation of all stakeholders in ensuring the success of this initiative is both anticipated and appreciated.
