GRADE 9 COMMON TESTS

- Assessment Instruction 19 of 2011, dated 08 March 2011, has reference.
- A final timetable for the Grade 9 common tests in November 2011 is attached for information and further planning of teaching, learning and assessment activities. ANNEXURE A
- The formal test is compulsory for all schools with Grade 9 learners. This
 includes Independent schools that receive a subsidy from the Department of
 Education and offer the National Curriculum Statement (NCS).
- All Learning Areas in Grade 9 will be examined externally in November 2011 and this shall comprise 25% of the total assessment mark.



- It is important to note that the duration of examinations for Languages is 2.5 hours and all other Learning Areas are 2 hours.
- All learners registered in Grade 9 will be provided with a question paper, packed per school, per district and per language version.

GRADE 6 COMMON TESTS

- Assessment Instruction 32 of 2011, dated 23 May 2011, has reference.
- A final timetable for the Grade 6 common tests in November 2011 is attached for information and further planning of teaching, learning and assessment activities. ANNEXURE B
- The common test is compulsory for all schools with Grade 6 learners. This
 includes Independent schools that receive a subsidy from the Department of
 Education and offer the National Curriculum Statement (NCS).
- All Languages and Mathematics in Grade 6 will be examined externally in November 2011 and this shall comprise 25% of the total assessment mark.
- 11. It is important to note that the duration of examinations for Languages is 2.5 hours and Mathematics is 2 hours.
- 12. All learners registered in Grade 6 will be provided with a question paper for Home Language (H L), First Additional Language (FAL) and Mathematics packed per school, per district and per language version.

GRADE 3 COMMON TESTS

- Assessment Instruction 32 of 2011, dated 23 May 2011, has reference.
- 14. A final timetable for the Grade 3 common tests in November 2011 is attached for information and further planning of teaching, learning and assessment activities. ANNEXURE C
- 15. The formal assessment is compulsory for all schools with Grade 3 learners. This includes Independent schools that receive a subsidy from the Department of Education and offer the National Curriculum Statement (NCS).
- Question papers for Grade 3 will be provided for Literacy and Numeracy only in November 2011.



- It is important to note that the duration of examinations for Literacy and Numeracy is 1 hour.
- 18. All learners registered in Grade 3 will be provided with a question paper for Literacy and Numeracy in Home Languages, packed per school, per district and per language version.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

- 19. Principals are cautioned that altering a Provincial common test question paper is an irregularity. This means that the entire common test question paper is to be written by all candidates and the entire script is to be marked as per the marking memorandum issued by the Province. This is compulsory for all public and the affected independent schools.
- 20. Marking memoranda may under no circumstances be altered if work has not been completed at the school. The candidates must be awarded zero marks for that section.
- 21. All schools are to complete all the Grade 3, 6 and 9 Learning Outcomes in all Learning Areas at the school prior to the start of the final common tests
- 22. District Directors and School Principals are kindly requested to disseminate this information as quickly as possible to all Grade 3, 6 and 9 teachers and learners.
