<p><b>2008 GRADE 11 FINAL EXAMINATION REVISED TIMETABLE</b></p>
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The memorandum dated 09 August 2008 and to which a draft Grade 11 examination time table was attached, has reference.

Kindly find attached the final revised time table for the Grade 11 Final Examination. Principals who took the time to comment are thanked for their input. Where possible, changes have been implemented based on the comments received.

**CLASHES OF SUBJECTS IN GRADE 11.**

Please note that schools that experience clashes of subjects on the attached time table will be given guidance by the Provincial Assessment & Examinations Directorate in utilising the isolation procedure contained in the rules and regulations governing the National Senior Certificate Examination.

**POINTS THAT MUST BE NOTED.**

- The rationale behind the 12h30 start for major subjects is that the majority of schools in the Eastern Cape will use all available classrooms to accommodate

Grade 12 and Grade 9 learners in the morning session and the Grade 11 time table must take this into consideration.

- No schools may write papers at a different time on the date indicated.
- The Grade 11 examination is compulsory for all schools with registered Grade 11 learners.
- No question papers for Agricultural Technology and Non-official languages will be supplied by the Province. Schools offering these subjects in Grade 11 must set these examinations.
- Marking memorandums will be supplied by the Province and all schools will mark Grade 11 examinations internally.
